1.	Welcome and Apologies	
	FP welcomed Directors to the meeting. KE presented the	
	apologies.	
2.	Subject of Extraordinary Meeting	
	FP stated the subject of the meeting is the purchase of	
	Glentarff house. Scottish Canals conditions of the sale are	
	standard if the property remains rented, in which case the	
	15-year condition will not affect FAGCC.	
	IL advised that the Scottish Land Fund will not accept those	
	conditions IL indicated that if FAGCC pay the full price or	
	counteroffer with 10% reduction it would be reasonable to	
	ask for the removal of those conditions. If a discount were	
	agreed, a clawback of the discount value for a 5 year period	
	would be reasonable.	
	FP asked how much SLF are willing to fund.	
	IL stated FAGCC have asked for £180,000 but that amount	
	is unlikely to be approved as they will only fund maximum of	
	85%. There will also be legal bills and a 6% additional	
	building tax as we already own properties. These costs	
	however could be covered by SLF	
3.	Discussion	
	There was a general discussion where there was agreement	
	that paying the full asking price would be simpler and	
	quicker.	
	LW asked if FAGCC offer Scottish Canals the full price can	
	we ask for quick completion.	
	IL Agreed that we could and that three months should be	
	sufficient time for completion.	

The Board unanimously agreed to offer full price subject to removal of conditions.

IL was asked to continue to act on behalf of FAGCC in this matter with Scottish Canals and to now instruct our Solicitor accordingly.

IL The valuation of Glentarff House is based on free title so selling with conditions attached would render the valuation inaccurate in any case. However, it is best to maintain good relations with Scottish Canals in case further requests are made in the future.

FP thanked everyone for their time and closed the meeting.
